Exercise Slides <i>Discussion</i>	Check & Convert <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Is conversion possible?</i>• <i>Typically convert to "Reflection" Question with Expert Response for self-paced E-Learning</i>• <i>No Correct/Incorrect feedback for this</i>	1 minute per exercise		
Exercise Slides <i>Lab Activity</i>	Check & Convert <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Is conversion possible?</i>• <i>If software application, convert to procedure simulations</i>• <i>If equipment, convert to explore simulations</i>• <i>One simulation/task is assumed to have 7-10 steps/clicks.</i>	1 minute per exercise
