


Certificate Program in Instructional Design - Level 2





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OVERVIEW

ID Mentors offers **Certificate Programs in Instructional Design**. The program covers the entire gamut of knowledge and skills that an individual needs to possess in order to function as an instructional designer in the learning design industry.

Our program is industry oriented, and a good mix of theory and practice. It equips students with the necessary theoretical background and practical skills so that the student can function in any industry/domain and in any learning medium.

LEVEL 2: INTERMEDIATE CERTIFICATE COURSE

This is a blended learning program created specifically for practicing instructional designers.

- It addresses the basic principles of learning and motivation, and a walkthrough of the tasks that you need to complete for storyboarding and designing.
- It presents popular frameworks, and showcases how these are used in designing learning material.
- You get to see how these principles manifest in the creation of the following deliverables: Program Outline, Detailed Design, and E-Learning Storyboards.
- You also learn how instructional design varies for different audience profile by deconstructing two of our online courses, Discover ID and ID @ Work.

- Storyboarding: Script a scenario-based storyboard OR a storyboard for an explainer video.

Course # 1: Scripting an Instructional Unit






ID @ Work: Mind Map

COST

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS


How is the program structured?

The program has three levels:

- Level 1 Basic Certificate Course in Instructional Design 15 Days to 1 Month
- Level 2 Intermediate Certificate Course in Instructional Design 2 to 3 Months
- Level 3 Advanced Certificate Course in Instructional Design 3 to 4 Months

How is the program delivered?

The mode of delivery of our program is blended – contact sessions and online courses. There will be **contact sessions** conducted with the student using video conferencing software that will orient the student and address any doubts that the student may have. The **online courses** will contain the content and have been designed as structured courses/short learning pieces so that students can take the lessons anywhere, anytime. It is very important for an instructional designer who is going to design e-learning to use e-learning and understand the medium.



What if I have doubts during online courses?

During the course of the online lessons, if the student has any doubts, the student can enter them in the **online discussion forum**. We answer the questions promptly. For complex questions, students can make use of the **contact sessions** with Purnima Valiathan to resolve doubts/queries.



How many contact sessions?

Formally, we provide **3 contact sessions** in this program. The student may also call up Purnima for clarifying doubts with prior scheduling/appointment. If needed, we will arrange for more contact sessions.

Do you help me stay on course?

We track the student's progress throughout the program and send out regular communication in the form of updates and reminders through their preferred medium to ensure that they are on track.

How about assessments?

At the end of each course/level, the student has to take an **online assessment**. In addition to the online assessments, students are given **assignments**. These assignments provide the student an opportunity to practice the skills he/she gained. We evaluate the assessments and the assignments, and provide detailed feedback and guidance and if needed remedial material.

What are my take-aways?

Besides the knowledge and skills that you gain through this program, you get:

- 1) A **certificate** stating that you have successfully completed the program (if you clear the online assessment and complete the assignments successfully)
- 2) A **portfolio** of assignments that you completed during the course of the program
- 3) **One-to-one learning sessions** with a leading expert in Instructional Design Purnima Valiathan
